After allocation of seats through JOSAA (B.Tech. in CSE and IT), some seats may remain vacant as candidates allotted seats may not join the institute. In anticipation of vacant seats, IIITV is planning to conduct a spot-admission round at the institute premises.

Eligibility:

Candidates with a valid JEE Main rank, and fulfilling JOSAA eligibility criteria, are eligible to apply to IIITV spot-admissions.

Criteria of allotment:

Allotment will be as per the JEE Main 2018 rank (respective categories). The process will ensure that there is no merit violation.

- 1. Fill up the online registration form to receive announcements related to IIITV-spot-admission
- 2. A comprehensive list of vacant seats (category wise) will be put up on the institute website (date of announcement of available vacant seats may change if there is any change in JOSAA/ CSAB counselling schedule)
- 3. Applications as per the IIITV-Spot-Admission application form will be received from 9:30 am till 11:30 am at the Institute premises.
- 4. Merit list will be prepared based on the physical applications received. Allotment of seats will be done thereafter.
- 5. Seats will be allotted to meritorious candidates only after scrutiny of certificates and receipt of fees.
- 6. The seat alloted must be confirmed within half an hour of the allotment is done. For accepting the seat and confirming the admission, the candidate or his / her guardian must be present at the Institute with copies of required certificates and with the fees of INR 1,13,470 to be paid in the form of a) a demand draft in favour of "Indian Institute of Information Technology Vadodara", b) credit or Debit Card, c) Bank Transfer.
- 7. Mess charges of INR 16,600 shall be payable via NEFT to mess vendor directly.
- 8. The institute spot round is independent of JOSAA admission process. Any amount, if deposited to JOSAA can not be adjusted in the fees mentioned above.
- 9. Once the fees is paid and the admission is confirmed by the candidate, the fees paid will be forfeited on cancellation of admission.

Candidates must qualify being in the top 20 percentile of their Board or with aggregate marks of 75% (65% for SC/STs). The aggregate marks for percentile cut-offs for different Boards has been put up on the JOSAA website.
